

The Krewe De Tigris
Policy on Committees
(12/21)

- I. **Purpose:** to describe the roles and responsibilities of the standard committees required for the operation of The Krewe de Tigris and the selection of committee chairs and members.
- II. **Selection of Committee chairs:** Each year the executive committee shall submit to the board a list of candidates to serve as committee chairs for the following year. The board will review and approve the slate prior to the beginning of the beginning of each Krewe Year starting May 1st.
- III. **Committees, Rolls and Responsibilities**
 - a. **Parade Committee** is responsible for all preparation and coordination of parade weekend including but not limited to, coordination with local officials, parade route selection, float order, rider assignments, security, float preparation, and clean up. The Krewe Captain is the chair of this committee and shall oversee all functions related to the Krewe Parade.

Under this committee shall be the following:

 - I. Float Captain: responsible for all construction, maintenance, and security of the Krewe's float fleet.
 - b. **Communications Committee:** is the webmaster and is responsible for all media and promotion of all public Krewe events.
 - c. **Ball Committee** has overall responsibility for conducting and organizing the Krewe Ball. The responsibilities include but are not limited to, location selection, timing of the event, food and beverage selection, and selection of the entertainment.
 - d. **Tableau Committee** Is responsible for the presentation of the King and Queen and programming during the ball.
 - e. **Social Committee** has the responsibility of coordinating all official Krewe holiday parties, House parties and events not otherwise described. The responsibilities include location selection, food and beverage coordination, theme selection, setup, and cleanup for the events.
 - f. **Krewe cares/outreach** is responsible for both internal and external outreach, philanthropy and community events . Each year, the King and Queen will determine one community philanthropy to support and events to support the chosen philanthropy. The board must hold a vote to approve the chosen philanthropy.
 - g. **Sponsorship** responsible for working with the community to solicit sponsorships and raise funds.
