

Krewe de Tigris Parade Policies
(12/2021)

I. **Purpose:** The purpose of this document is to outline the policies and procedures related to the Krewe de Tigris annual parade.

II. **Policies:**

A. Parade Day:

1. Parade is scheduled the Saturday before Fat Tuesday and held in downtown Auburn.
2. Krewe de Tigris members in good standing will be assigned rider spots on the Krewe Floats. NO EXCEPTIONS.

B. Parade Attire:

a) Float Riders:

- (1) All Riders will wear a mask or face paint to conceal their identity.
 - (a) If face jewels are worn, face paint must be worn, not makeup.
- (2) Float Themes will be determined by the Parade Committee with Board approval.
- (3) Riders will dress according to the float theme of the float to which they are assigned.
- (4) Only adult Krewe members, no extended family members, are permitted to ride.
- (5) Only One Parent will be permitted to ride on the kids float with their child.

b) Walkers

- (1) Each Krewe member must serve as a security walker for one year in order to be eligible to ride on a Krewe Sponsored float. .
 - (a) If you are a first time participant and have a child riding on the Krewe Kids Float, one parent may ride the kids float with your child. The other parent will be required to walk alongside the kids float.
- (2) No masks or throws are permitted.
- (3) Black Krewe de Tigris shirt must be worn to identify yourself as security.
- (4) Sunglasses may be worn.

C. Rider Packages:

1. Each member riding a Krewe float will have the opportunity to purchase a rider package (i.e., beads, throws) through the Krewe.
 - a) Different rider packages will be available to purchase in early winter.

2. You may choose to supplement your rider package with additional throws of your own.
 - a) Throws may not contain anything that can bounce under the floats and cause safety issues or concerns.
 - b) Throws must be family friendly and crowd appropriate. If you are not sure if a throw is appropriate, it probably is not.
 - c) Float marshals have the authority to remove inappropriate or unsafe throws from any Krewe members on their floats.
3. You may also choose to buy your own throws and not purchase any of the rider packages.

D. Member Behavior:

1. Members are encouraged to put their best behavior on display as this is our time to shine in the public eye.
2. All Beverages should be poured into and consumed from a cup. Absolutely no alcohol containers should be visible at any time.
3. Any member found to be behaving in a manner that violates Parade Policy will be provided a warning. If the behavior persists, the member will be required to serve a one year suspension from the following year's parade.
