

KREWE de TIGRIS MEMBERSHIP **(12/21)**

Membership may be capped at 350 members.
Krewe de Tigris will be comprised of singles and couples.
Krewe de Tigris represents the Auburn, Alabama area.

MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

NEW MEMBERS

Open enrollment for **new members** will occur twice a year; **March 1-April 1; and September 1-October 1.**

To request membership in the Krewe de Tigris, a membership application must be submitted online (krewedetigris.com).

The Membership chair will receive notification of applicants (from Webmaster) and submit names of potential members to the Board of Directors for approval.

The Board of Directors will vote on each member and majority rules. The Board of Directors reserve the right to decline membership to any applicants.

The Membership Chair will then email the potential new members, letting them know of their approval, and the need to pay dues by April 15th or October 15th (depending on session). New members not paying dues by deadline will be removed from the process.

NEW MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

1. New members will be required to attend Orientation. More than one session will be offered.
2. **New members of the Krewe de Tigris will serve on the Clean-up Committee of all social functions. The Social Chairs will be responsible for the clean-up committee. Failure to participate on Clean-up Committee will result in walking the parade a second year.**
3. **New members will be required to walk the parade. (am2/22/18)**

(First year Krewe de Tigris members who are business owners and are sponsoring a float/group will be excused from walking due to the fact they have responsibilities tied to their sponsorship.)

Renewal of Current Members

Current Krewe de Tigris members who wish to renew their membership will do so by April 1. Dues and renewal forms must be completed online. (Krewedetigris.com)

The Webmaster will send daily updates of renewals to the Membership Chair until deadline has passed. Any member not renewing will be contacted by May 1 to ensure they are resigning. After May 1, current members may not renew until the next March.

The Krewe de Tigris reserves the right to deny or revoke membership to anyone, who knowingly puts the Krewe in danger, knowingly and repeatedly puts the krewe in unfavorable light, knowingly posts or shares information to cause strife or divide within the krewe. These matters will be brought before the Board of Directors who will be charged with reviewing and making the decision to remove or keep the member in question. A 2/3rd majority vote of the Board of Directors will be required to make a full decision.
